





Course Details-

School of Management have organized the Capability Enhancement Skill Programs for their students on the topic Logic and Critical Thinking.

By taking Introduction to Logic and Critical Thinking Students will improve their ability to identify, analyse, and evaluate arguments by other people and also to construct arguments of their own in order to convince others and to help them decide what to believe or do.

This Course introduces general standards of good reasoning and offers tools to improve student's critical thinking skills. These skills will help them determine when an argument is being given, what its crucial parts are, and what it assumes implicitly. The students will also learn how to apply deductive and inductive standards for assessing arguments and how to detect and avoid fallacies.

Course Objectives –

- Develop inferential and argumentative skills
- Learn to identify and reconstruct arguments
- Learn to evaluate arguments, distinguishing good from bad arguments (fallacies)
- Learn to use formal logic tools in order to evaluate deductive reasoning and to use informal logic tools in order to evaluate non deductive reasoning

Course Outcome-

By the end of this course, students will be able to:

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- Identify the main issue and premises of an argument;
- Be able to recognize and define the primary terms in the reasoning process.
- Be able to identify and apply the terms, the methods and the normative conditions of the reasoning process to any exercise of reasoning.
- Students will be able to critically judge the logic of a particular case, but also critically argue for an extension of logic through its applications.


